Cayuga Lake Restoration Plan

Proposed Project Location: Campbell Meadow Park; Pickney Road & Lower Creek Rd.; Fall Creek,

Landowner *Town of Dryden and Private Landowners*

Issue to be addressed: Sediment transport from tributary ditch to Fall Creek, removal of significant gravel bar at tributary outlet and bank erosion would be addressed. Erosion noted around bridge and at multiple areas on the banks. High profile, but perhaps low traffic site.

Proposed Project or Action Stream bank stabilization and tributary stabilization, clean out.
