**PROPOSED PROJECT #23A: Interlaken Detention Pond and Soil Stabilization/Streambank Restoration, Village of Interlaken**

Cayuga Lake Watershed Restoration and Protection Plan

**Proposed Project Location:** Unnamed stream that runs west to east through the Village of Interlaken (uphill from the Village of Interlaken/runs parallel to NYS Rte. 96Apst the old water tower site, crosses 96A, north through private property before turning east towards Lively Run below the Village)

**Landowner:** Public(?)and Private (unnamed)

**Issue to be addressed:** Streambank erosion and downstream flooding at 96A at Knight Street and the junction of Rte. 96 and 96A

**Proposed Project or Action:** Construction of a detention pond at the old water tower site; plantings to reduce velocity and stabilize streambank and reduce downstream flooding.
