PROPOSED PROJECT #27: Salmon Creek Stabilization, Town of Lansing

Proposed Project Category: can address more than one issue

1. Stormwater management and erosion control

Does project relate to/advance any existing local, regional, watershed, or statewide plans?

Cayuga Lake Watershed Restoration and Protection Plan

Proposed Project Location: Salmon Creek in Myers Park (near Myers Rd and Lakeshore Rd)

Landowner: Town of Lansing

Issue to be addressed: Streambank erosion at the mouth of Salmon Creek

Proposed Project or Action: The Town of Lansing will install approximately 354 linear feet of rip-rap for shoreline protection on Salmon Creek within Myers Park. Shoreline protection will stabilize the bank and reduce the level of sediment entering Cayuga Lake.
